

# ARRANGEMENT INFORMATION SHEET

## How to get to PakSong

**Eco-Logic** is located at a beautiful, but rather isolated spot surrounded by mountains and rainforests. Getting there is nevertheless easy. You have to travel to the village of **PakSong** (Phato municipality). Even though we are in Chumpon province, the city of **Ranong** on the west coast is nearest.

**THE BEST WAY TO TRAVEL TOWARDS US IS VIA RANONG** (the nearest big city on the west coast).

- From Bangkok or from the south (Phuket) you can take a bus to Ranong.
- From Ranong you can take the 10 o'clock bus, destination Surathane/Hadyai.
- If you arrive on a different time in Ranong, you can also take a minivan (until 15.00 o'clock in the afternoon)
- You get out after about 50 minutes on the main road, close to a small T-section in **PakSong**. **THIS IS OUR MEETING/PICK UP POINT!**

If you get there, find yourself a place to sit and have a drink (opposite the road) while you wait for us to pick you up. You can also choose to walk down the road to the right for 15 minutes, there are signs directing you to Eco-Logic. Once at our premises, take the road **up** to our restaurant.

**Meeting day:** depending on your arrival day

**Meeting time:** depending on your bus

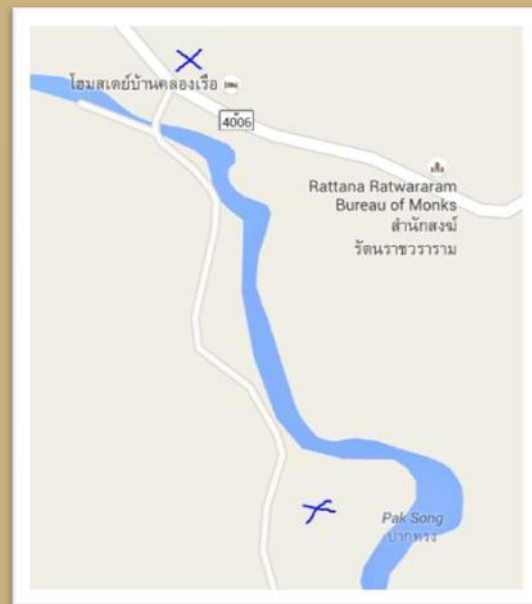
**Meeting point:** the meeting point is on the main road (N4006), PakSong T-section.

## How to travel to Ranong and PakSong:

1. From Bangkok, you travel to **Ranong** (west coast) **at least one day ahead**. Regular busses leave from Bangkok from the Southern Bus Terminal at Nakhorn Chaisri Road **in the morning and evening**. The bus trip takes about 10 hours.
2. From the South (Krabi, Phuket), you travel to **Ranong** (west coast) **at least one day ahead**. Busses leave from the bus terminals towards Ranong. The bus trip takes about 5 hours (Krabi) to 6-7 hours (Phuket).
3. Once in Ranong: there is a guesthouse close to the bus station of Ranong (named **Kiwi**) and many other guesthouses and hotels in the center of Ranong. The staff at **Kiwi** can help you and inform you about coming to Eco-Logic, they know us well. It's also a place for a coffee and breakfast, they open early in the morning.
4. From **Ranong**, you take the early morning bus (9 and 10 o'clock) towards Surathane and/or HatYai. Tell the ticket seller (ON the bus!) you want to go to PakSong. You pay for your ticket when you are in the bus. You can use the map on this information sheet to show where you want to go.
5. Get off the bus in PakSong.
6. We will be waiting for you at the meeting point.

**Please confirm your arrival day and time to us via email or telephone.**

**Please note:** Ranong is the **last** place to change money / use ATM, before coming to PakSong.



It is also possible to travel to Ranong by airplane from Bangkok (NokAir). We can organize a taxi from the airport to our place.

Are you coming from Krabi or Phuket? You can consider leaving the bus 25 km before Ranong, at the Radchakrud intersection. We can organize a taxi from there to the resort. It will save you a lot of travel time and waiting for the bus transfers.
